

Justice For Beng Hock Answers For Rakyat!



The sudden and tragic death of Teoh Beng Hock, political secretary to DAP Selangor Chairman and a State Executive Councillor, Ean Yong Hian Wah, and a former reporter with Sin Chew Daily while in the custody of the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) has shocked and saddened all Malaysians.

Beng Hock, 30, was taken to the MACC's Selangor headquarters in Shah Alam for questioning on Wednesday at 5.40pm on 15/7/2009. This was part of MACC's attempt to harrass DAP and other Pakatan Rakyat state assemblymen, and to "fish" for information. However, Beng Hock's body was found on the balcony of the 5th floor - 9 floors below the MACC office at around 1pm the very next day.

Beng Hock was scheduled to be married on the day he died, leaves behind his fiancee and family members

who are completely distraught and in disbelief over what has happened.

We strongly condemn the suspicious and unexplained circumstances surrounding his death and demand that:

The MACC must bear full responsibility for Beng Hock's ill treatment and death. What is most shocking was the fact that Beng Hock was a witness and not even a suspect in this investigations and he had fully cooperated with the investigating officers.

An independent Royal Commission of Inquiry must be set up immediately to investigate the death of Teoh Beng Hock. Only then can Malaysians discover the truth behind this senseless death, for we can no longer trust the honesty and integrity of the police force.

MACC must stop being the Barisan Nasional's lapdog and cease its selective persecution of DAP and Pakatan Rakyat elected representatives on frivolous grounds. This victimisation has now gone too far, with the loss of life of a bright and talented young man.

We want MACC to focus on landing the sharks which are bankrupting our country like the culprits of the RM12.5 billion PKFZ scandal. We demand answers from MACC on this senseless death and we want heads to roll at the highest levels for this act of sheer incompetence, criminal negligence and complete lack of accountability.
